

GENERAL SCHOOL RULES

GIRL'S UNIFORM

Skirt	Blue, regulation length, just above the knee
Blouses	White – Old blouse to be tucked in at ALL times
Tie	Long/old tie to be worn with old blouse in terms 2 and 3 New tie to be worn with new blouse at ALL times
Shoes	Black leather school shoes – Fully enclosed
Socks	White, NO decoration
Sports Uniform	Worn ONLY on HPE or Agriculture timetabled days
Sports T-shirt	Can be left untucked by choice
Sports Shorts	Plain navy blue
Sports Shoes	Joggers with white socks
Hat	School hat ONLY – NO HAT, NO PLAY!
Navy Slacks/Trousers	To be purchased from MSB Uniform Shop – worn with school blouse
Navy Track Pants	Worn ONLY with Sports Uniform
Stockings	Navy or Flesh coloured
Jumper/Parka	MSB regulation ONLY

BOY'S UNIFORM

Shorts	Navy
Socks	Regulation grey
Shoes	Black leather school shoes – Fully enclosed
Sports Uniform	Worn ONLY on HPE or Agriculture timetabled days
Sports T-shirt	Can be left untucked by choice
Sports Shorts	Plain navy blue
Sports Shoes	Joggers with white socks
Hat	School hat ONLY – NO HAT, NO PLAY!
Tie	Worn in Terms 2 & 3
Navy Trousers	Worn with school shirt
Belt	Black ONLY
Navy Track Pants	Worn ONLY with Sports Uniform
Jumper/Parka	MSB Regulation ONLY

JEWELLERY

Watch; ONE small plain ring; ONE small pair sleepers or studs – no other visible studs allowed. ONE thin chain with religious symbol tucked into shirt; hair is to be of an acceptable colour and to be neat and tidy at all times – at the discretion of the College Administration. The College Badge is worn on formal occasions.

ALL items of value are to be handed into the office for safe keeping.

Confiscated items cannot be collected until End of Term. Administration takes no responsibility for confiscated items. Mobile phones may be returned after negotiation with parents.

BANNED ITEMS

Chewing gum, alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, all aerosol cans (including deodorants), matches/lighters, knives are strictly forbidden at Mount St Bernard College.

LOCKERS

Lockers are supplied to all students to assist them with their responsibility in keeping their possessions safe and in being organised. **Students are to supply their own lock**, and the spare key or combination is to be handed into the Home Form teacher with the student's name. **Students are to keep their locker locked at all times.** Any items of value are to be handed in at the office of a morning for safe keeping. The College will NOT be held responsible for any losses. Lockers are to be accessed **BEFORE** school and **DURING** morning tea or lunch **ONLY**.

BAGS, BOOKS & EQUIPMENT

Before school – Prepare for Periods 1 & 2

Morning tea – Prepare for Periods 3 & 4

Lunch – Prepare for Periods 5 & 6

DIARIES are to be with you ALL day in EVERY class, including Roll Call.

Bags are to be kept in lockers, NOT in the classrooms.

NO metal rulers or liquid paper are allowed at Mount St Bernard College.

CONDUCT

Be respectful at all times to all students, teachers and community members.

Loud, disruptive behaviour and bad language is totally unacceptable.

Stealing and vandalism of property is strictly forbidden at Mount St Bernard College.

Bus Travel behaviour is to be exemplary. You must remember you are representing Mount St Bernard College at all times.

Bullying at Mount St Bernard College is totally unacceptable at all times.

DISCMANS/WALKMANS ETC:

Students will not be allowed to bring any such device into the classroom. Boarder students must leave such devices in the Boarding School prior to coming into the day school. Day students who bring such devices to school must leave them at the front office on arrival and collect them again at the end of the day after roll call. Any student not complying will have the discman/walkman confiscated until the end of semester.

DIGITAL RECORDING DEVICES (DRD'S)

Students may bring such devices to school but they must be left at the front office. Use of DRD's will be at the discretion of each individual teacher and must be curriculum orientated. In such cases the student will collect their DRD from the office prior to the particular period and return it at the end of the period. Students not complying will have their DRD confiscated until the end of semester.

CONFISCATED JEWELLERY, CLOTHING, WALKMANS/DISCMANS/DRD'S

Confiscated items will be placed in a named envelope and will then be retained by administration and returned before the last day of the term.

MUSIC IN CLASSROOMS

The playing of music in class during a lesson will be at the discretion of the teacher and will be teacher directed and controlled.

This will only be allowed if it is not disruptive to neighbouring classes and does not cause excessive use of Internet bandwidth.
