Introduction

Mount St Bernard College offers General Excellence Scholarships annually to students entering Year 10. The scholarship program exists to foster diversity by ensuring that an education at Mount St Bernard College is available to as wide a range of students as possible. Our scholarship program seeks to offer places to students who will contribute to the richness and diversity of the College's community.

Criteria

- Applicants must be in Year 9 at the time of application.
- The scholarship is open to internal and *external students.
- The scholarship is awarded to a student who has an outstanding academic ability which is supported by a particular talent in an additional area.

Process

- Applications must be received by end of Term 3, 2023.
- Applicants who are short listed, will be notified and may be interviewed by a panel which comprises of Mount St Bernard College senior staff.
- The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal. No award shall be made if, in the opinion of the Principal, no candidate is of sufficient merit.

Award

- The scholarship will entitle the successful applicant to 50% discount on tuition fees for three (3) years (Years 10 to 12).
- Two scholarships are awarded per annum. One for an internal student and a second for an external student.
- An annual review of successful recipient/s will occur in December each year so that satisfactory progress is maintained.
- The successful applicants will receive a framed certificate acknowledging this achievement.

Expectations

- The successful applicants will be asked to speak at a gathering as a scholarship recipient.
- The successful applicants will be photographed and acknowledged in the College publications and on the website.
