2026 Senior Academic Scholarship

Introduction

Mount St Bernard College is offering 15 Senior Academic Full Scholarships to students entering Year 11 or 12 in 2025. The scholarship program exists to offer academically focussed students an education at Mount St Bernard College that will assist to maximise their senior aspirations. Our scholarship program seeks to offer places to students who seek the advantage of small class sizes, focussed senior education, and will contribute to the richness and diversity of the College's community.

Criteria

- Applicants must be entering Year 11 or 12 in 2026 at the time of application.
- The scholarships are open to all students.
- The scholarships will be awarded to students who have a sound academic merit and a desire to continue their senior studies and will be based upon reports, test results and any supporting cover letter written by the student and/or current School Principal.

Process

- Applications must be received by the end of Term 3, 2025
- An interview will take place with the Principal or College Executive member.
- The scholarship will be awarded at the discretion of the Principal. No award shall be made if, in the opinion of the Principal, no candidate is of sufficient merit.

Award

- The scholarship will entitle the successful applicant to 100% discount on tuition fees only for two years (Years 11 & 12).
- Up to 15 scholarships may be awarded per annum.
- An annual review of the successful recipient/s will occur in December each year to ensure satisfactory progress is maintained.
- The successful applicants will receive a framed certificate acknowledging this achievement.

Expectations

- The successful applicants may be asked to speak at a College assembly or gathering as a scholarship recipient.
- The successful applicants will be photographed and acknowledged in the College publications and on the website.
